




Bowling Club news continued....

VALE - LLOYD (Ben) BENNETTS - 8 December 1941-7 July 2023

Ben joined our Club in October 2009 as a pennant player in our third division. He undertook Club Treasurer duties for twelve months in 2011 and the duty of Bar Manager together with his great mate Curly Smart for nine years from 2011 to 2020 which ensured not only finance profitability for the Club but also a most sociable host. He was also readily available to work the bar for our summer Night Owls games. During the off-season Ben also undertook the bar duties for the Clarendon Netball Club who use our facilities for their weekly presentations. Ben had two successful seasons in the Club Championships winning the Drawn Pairs with Greg Bulger in 2011/12 and with Mike Scott in 2021/22. He was also a regular participant of Pete's Pairs on Wednesdays. Ben had a career in teaching and became a school Principal, with several placements on the Eyre Peninsula and Kangaroo Island. He rarely spoke of his achievements, but we do know now that he had obtained four university degrees and won the Outstanding Young Australian of the Year award in 1979 and a Public Service Medal in January 2004. Both awards related to his work with children with disabilities, particularly with designing education courses tailored to their unique needs and learning styles.

Ben was also a very accomplished football and cricket player. We will miss not seeing him at his chair at the bar or on the green but will remember him as a loyal club member who did his bit for the betterment of the Club.
